Science Scholarship Rules

Applications may be available at the Guidance Counselor's office
or at the Family Practice Center.

1. The applicant must be seeking a four-year Bachelor of Science degree with plans to enter a science related field.
2. The applicant must submit either ACT or SAT scores and a copy of transcripts.
3. The applicant must plan to use the scholarship for further education during the award year.
4. The application must be completed in full and returned to the Family Practice Center by April 15, 2010.
5. **The applicant must also complete an essay. The essay should be between 250-500 words each. Choose from the following topics for your essay:**
 - **Why is the choice of a career in a science related field the right choice for you? What are your dreams of the future?**
 - **Does any attribute, quality, or skill distinguish you from everyone else? How did you develop this attribute?**
 - **Have you ever struggled mightily for something and failed? How did you respond?**
6. Attach a personal statement to your application that describes how obtaining this degree will help fulfill your expectations and ambitions.

The essays should be typed and double-spaced.

Note: When selecting the student to receive the award, the Physicians consider the essay a crucial part of their decision. Occasionally, the Physicians' decision for a scholarship winner may tie. In such an instance, the Physicians split the award among multiple winners.
